Geographic Scope

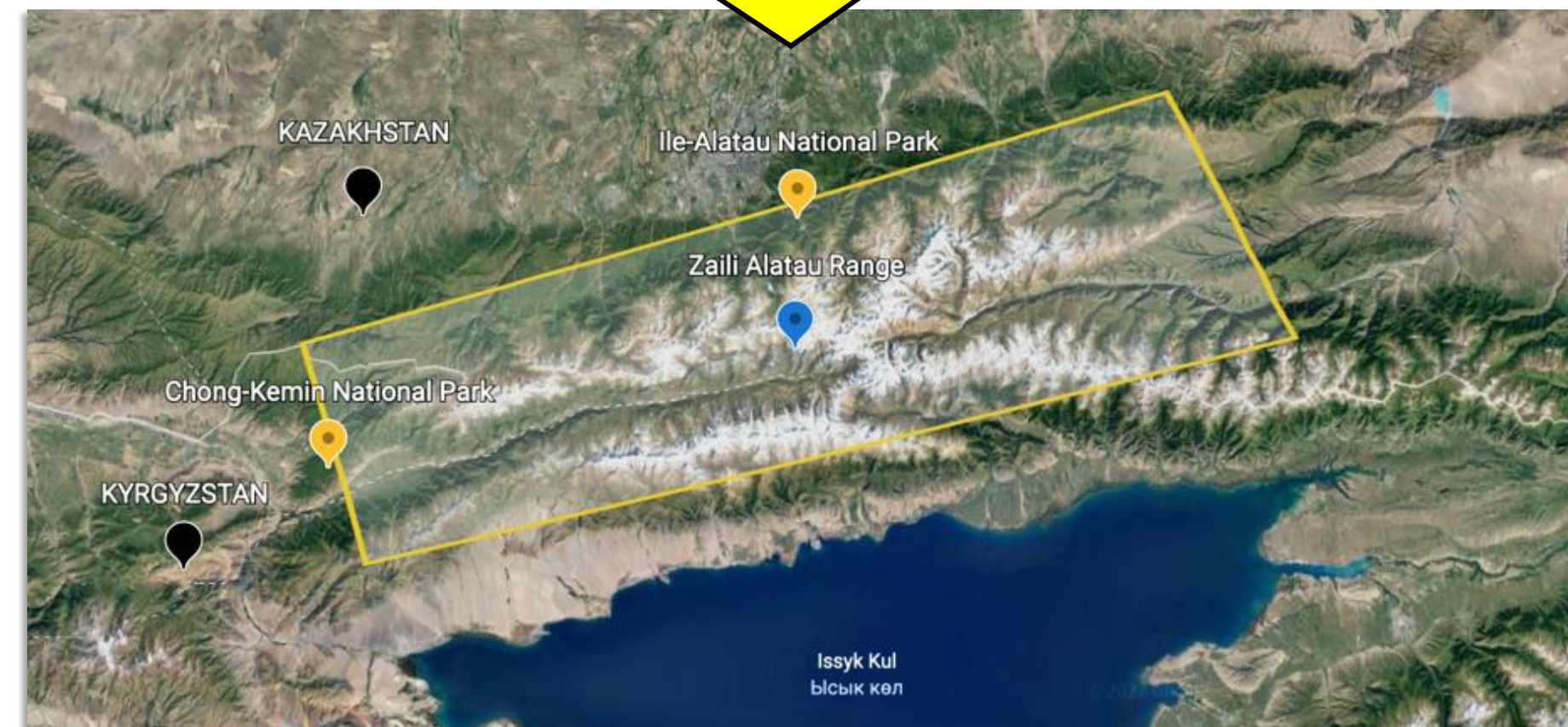
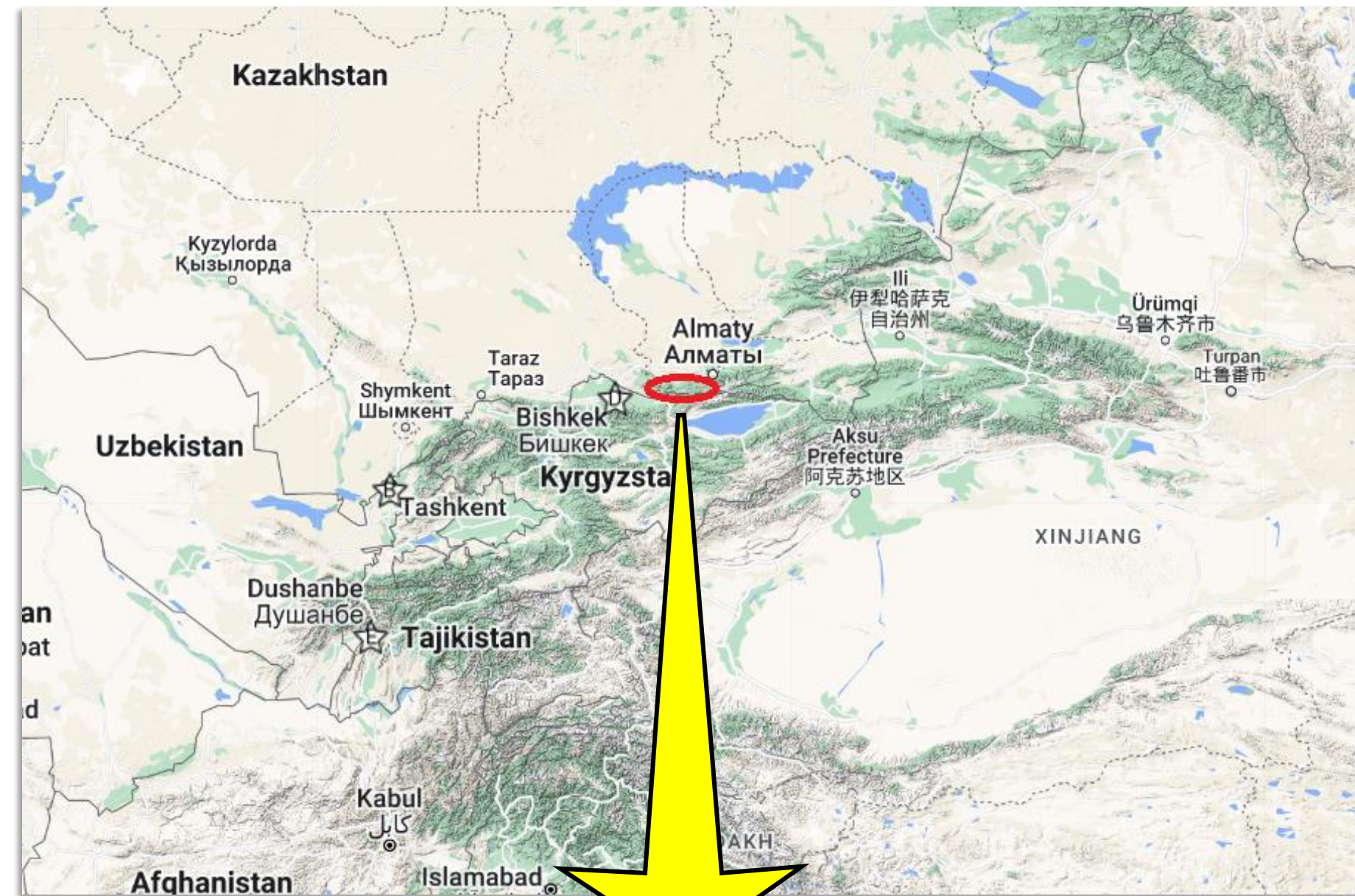
- 2 PAs located on transboundary ridge of Northern Tien-Shan Mountains
- 2 separate PAs share one ecosystem of Zaili-Alatau Mountain Range

Need for Cooperation

- Both protected areas are of high biodiversity value
- Many wildlife species incl. snow leopard, ibex. etc.
- Conservation efforts pursued, but without transboundary cooperation cannot yield results to fullest potential

Opportunities

- Political buy-in: Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan ministries understand importance, the need for transboundary cooperation
- 2 ministries agree to cooperate
